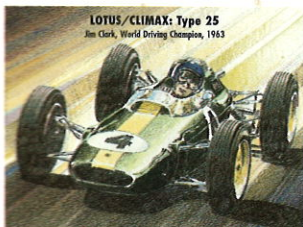


LOTUS/CLIMAX: Type 33. Jim Clark winning the German Grand Prix at the Nürburgring, World Driving Champion, 1965



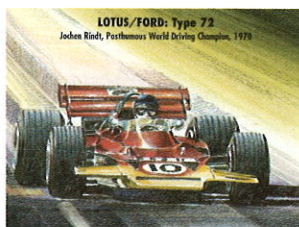
LOTUS/FORD: Type 38. Jim Clark winning the Indianapolis 500, 1965

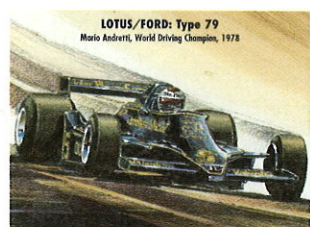

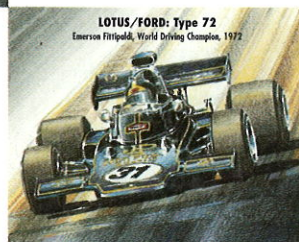

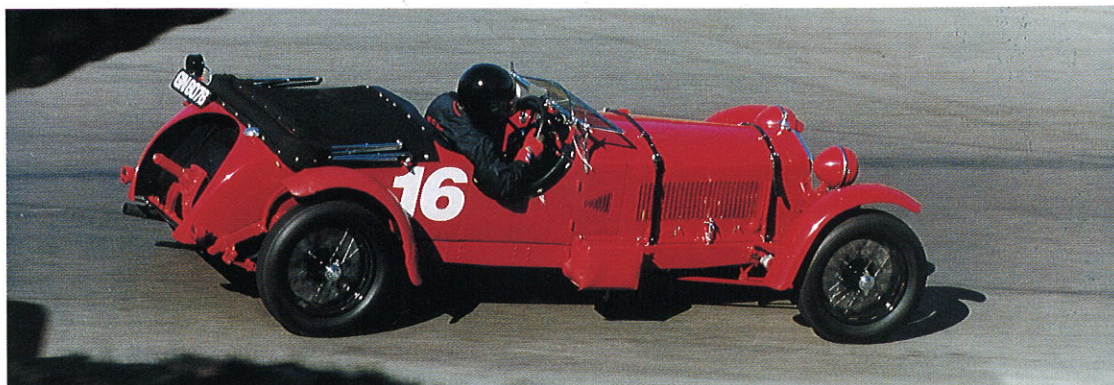
